Everyone's work added up to over 150 hours of labor. This labor was not in vain. The House of God was fresh and clean on Resurrection Sunday!

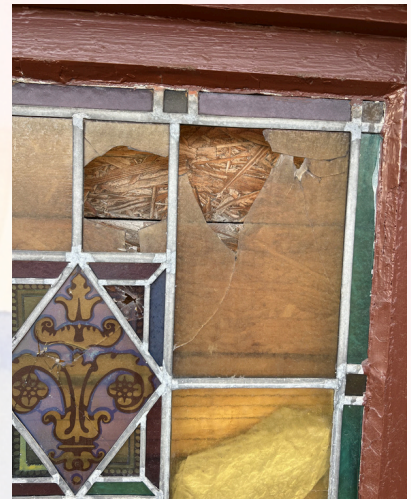
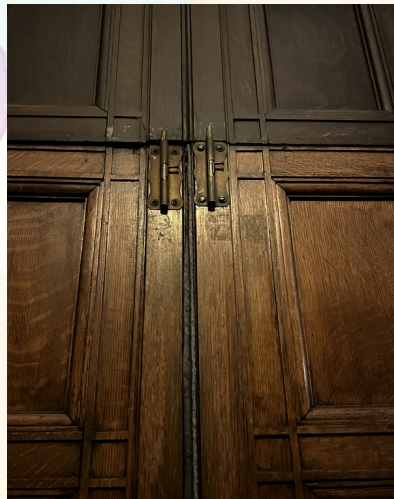


# LEAVING WINTER... ENTERING SPRING

After the long and bitterly cold winter of 2026, the church experienced many repairs to our plumbing system and the steam and return pipes in the boiler system. These expensive repairs kept the building warm and inviting.

This spring, there are projects planned for the sound system, window glass replacement, terra cotta repairs on the front portico and the modernization of a front door. Two years ago, a vandal broke stained glass on two windows by the handicap entrance. This spring, the windows will be removed and the glass replaced along with structural repair.

## **Pentecostal Church of Christ Endowment Fund**

An Endowment Fund consists of invested monies designated for a specific use. The Endowment Fund at Pentecostal Church of Christ has two functions. Both are designed to support future needs. One is for the Scholarship Foundation. The other is for future capital repairs and restoration. Monies can only be used for these specific uses. Some members have already made arrangements with their financial advisors or insurance providers for a legacy gift to the church. Others give as they are able. The monies given are not spent.

As the investments grow in value, only the monies gained through growth are used. Original investments remain and continue to grow. This is why monetary gifts continue to be a legacy to the life of the giver. Feel free to speak to leadership or a PCC Board Member for more clarification.



## **The Chest**

During every service a wooden chest is opened during offering time. All the monies placed in this chest are used for both current repairs and current restoration projects. Upkeep on the building and safety improvements are ongoing. Plumbing, heating, electrical and major restoration are costly but mandatory to ensure that the sanctuary is comfortable, safe and preserved. Feel free to ask leadership about current projects and their costs. The support of each and every member ensures that this faith community continues.

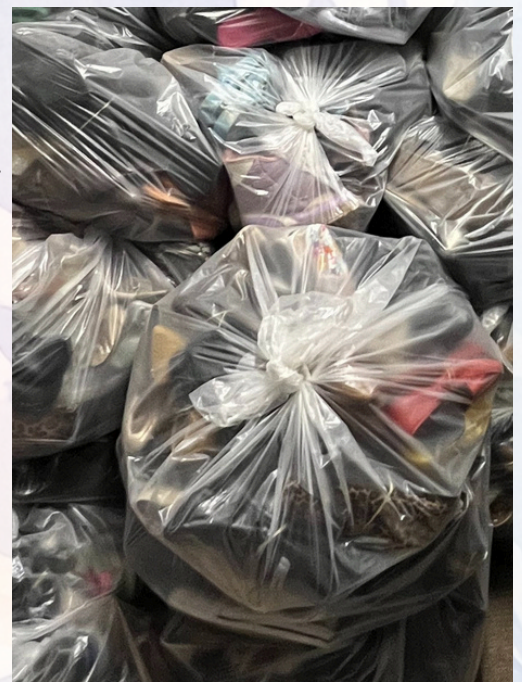
## **SHOE DRIVE: THE MOUNTAIN OF SHOES IS GROWING AND GROWING**

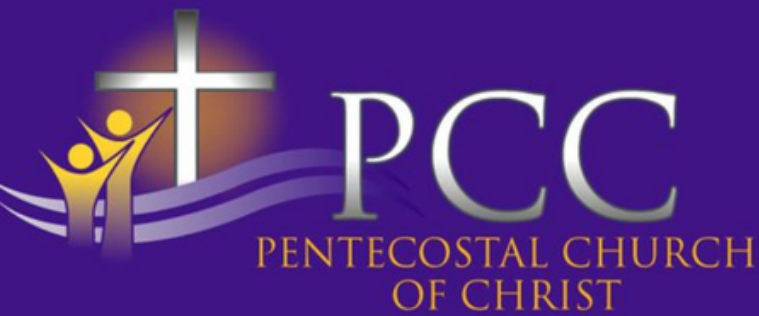
